About the Keystone Awards

The Keystone Media Awards, which date back to the 1950's, reinforce excellence by individuals in the news profession, by recognizing journalism that consistently provides relevance, integrity and initiative in serving readers, and faithfully fulfills its First Amendment rights and responsibilities. Further, the Keystone Media Awards stimulate journalists to improve their craft and ultimately improve their community.

First, second and honorable mention awards are presented in each category, as determined by the judges. Judges are given the discretion to not award a winner in any place or category or give no award at all based on the number of entries received in that category. Points are tallied for each winning entry. The news media organizations accumulating the highest total points in each division are recognized as Sweepstakes winners. Broadcast organizations accumulating the highest total points in each division are recognized as Outstanding News Operation winners.

The PNA Foundation will supply plaques to all first-place winners and certificates to all second place and honorable mention Keystone Media Award winners in attendance today. At the conclusion of today's presentation, you may pick up certificates for those at your news organization who were unable to attend. 





Pennsylvania Newsroom Internship Program

In 2025, the Pennsylvania NewsMedia Association Foundation successfully completed a new initiative built around its three pillars for sustainable journalism. In partnership with the National Association of Black Journalists Philadelphia, the Pittsburgh Black Media Foundation and Temple University, PNAF launched a collaborative internship program designed to connect the next generation of journalism talent with newsrooms across Pennsylvania.

The program offered college students from universities statewide the opportunity to gain firsthand experience through paid summer internships at participating newsrooms. Supported by grants from a private donation and [The Lenfest Institute for Journalism](#), students earned a competitive wage of \$20 an hour for internships lasting nine to 12 weeks.

An expanded program returns in 2026, and newsrooms are encouraged to step forward as hosts. Participating in the program is an opportunity to invest in the future of local journalism while welcoming new energy, ideas and perspectives into your newsroom. Your involvement helps strengthen Pennsylvania's news ecosystem and supports the development of the journalists who will shape its future.




