The program kicks off on Sunday afternoon, March 22, at PA NewsMedia Association headquarters. Students will gather at 5 p.m. for dinner where they'll meet their mentors, get an overview of Harrisburg politics and prepare for the upcoming days.

On Monday and Tuesday, participants will spend two intensive days at the Capitol visiting with Harrisburg insiders, observing committees at work, catching the House and Senate in session, meeting legislators and talking with lobbyists. All the while, their assigned mentors will be guiding them and working one-on-one with them to produce a final project. Everyone will gather on Tuesday afternoon for a recap and final analysis. The program concludes by 5 p.m. on Tuesday, March 24.
