For more than 50 years, the Foundation has provided quality training and resources to PNA members while awarding excellence, working to increase public awareness of the First Amendment and developing the next generation of readers and journalists through a variety of programs, contests and funds.

In 2023, our training schedule has expanded and it keeps growing. We're offering monthly webinars – at no cost to PNA members – on legal and legislative priorities, advertising and revenue-generating ideas, audience development and editorial basics. Monthly roundtables specially designed for women in leadership, publishers, executives of weekly and small community publications, and classified advertising managers provide valuable networking and idea sharing. We're heading back On The Road for regional workshops across the state.

More than 3,700 entries are received and judged each year through a variety of contests with hundreds of journalists, sales staffs and students recognized for their outstanding efforts. The Fellows Fund for the Future Grant Program has awarded more than \$44,000 in support of podcasts, internships, special freelance coverage, database training, diversity efforts, climate reporting and audience-growth products across the state. In 2020, our COVID-19 News Support Grant Program distributed \$150,000 to news companies across Pennsylvania, helping many to stay in business through that tumultuous time.

THE COLONIAL GOLF AND TENNIS CLUB

is located at 4901 Linglestown Road, Harrisburg, not far from our headquarters. Colonial's golf course was first opened in 1910 as Colonial Country Club. The golf course was the foundation for Colonial Country Club and was moved to its current location in 1954. The design is an exquisite layout featuring holes cut over rolling hills and through large 100 plus-year-old trees. The course is a championship layout that was renovated in 2002-2003 by Arthur Hills - Steve Forest Design Associates to create larger greens and multiple tee boxes.
