For nearly 60 years, the PNAF has provided quality training and resources to PNA members while working to support the sustainability of local news through philanthropy and fundraising, training and recognition of professional and student journalists.

Expanded Training: In 2026, our training schedule continues to grow. PNAF offers monthly webinars and training – at no or low cost to PNA members – on legal and legislative priorities, advertising and revenue-generating ideas, audience development and editorial basics. Philanthropy Support: In August of 2025, PNAF partnered with Blue Engine Collaborative and Google News Initiative on a nine-month intensive sustainability lab that provided ten PNA members consultative training and coaching. This lab, that would have normally cost thousands of dollars per organization, was free of charge. The lab concluded in April of this year with amazing results including a collective 33% increase in sustainability across the Pennsylvania cohort.

Excellence Recognition: More than 4,000 entries are received and judged each year through a variety of contests with hundreds of journalists, sales staff and students recognized for their outstanding efforts with three key award programs: the PNAF Advertising Contest, the Professional Keystone Media Awards and the Student Keystone Media Awards.

Member Funding: In the last seven years, PNAF has awarded more than \$67,000 in support of podcasts, internships, special freelance coverage, database training, diversity efforts, climate reporting and audience-growth products across the state through donations and grants.

Newsroom Internships: In its second year, PNAF has dramatically increased its funding and participation in the Newsroom Internship Program. The program has raised \$115,000 for the 2026 program that will nearly double its intern count at participating news organizations this summer. Newsroom participation has also increased by 44 percent. PNAF will be creating a specific web portal to increase exposure of the program to students and displaced journalists looking for internships and career advancement.

About the course...

The Colonial Golf and Tennis Club is located at 4901 Linglestown Road, Harrisburg, not far from our headquarters. Colonial's golf course was first opened in 1910 as Colonial Country Club. The golf course was the foundation for Colonial Country Club and was moved to its current location in 1954. The design is an exquisite layout featuring holes cut over rolling hills and through large 100 plus-year-old trees. The course is a championship layout that was renovated in 2002-2003 by Arthur Hills - Steve Forest Design Associates to create larger greens and multiple tee boxes.
