FOUNDATION FELLOWS GRANTS MAKE A SIGNIFICANT IMPACT ACROSS PENNSYLVANIA

The PNA Foundation Fellows Fund for the Future has set aside money for journalism grants to be used by news companies to start new initiatives or enhance current projects. Since 2019, the PNA Foundation has proudly donated more than \$46,000 to 21 different news companies to fund podcasts, internships and student fellowships, special freelance coverage, database training, diversity efforts, climate change reporting, technology enhancements and new audience-growth products. From the northwest to the southeast corners of Pennsylvania, we've supported weekly and small daily publications, online only start-ups, nonprofit newsrooms, statewide programs and even a cyber high school's journalism efforts.
