An insider's guide to how Pennsylvania's state government works...and doesn't. The PNA Foundation has created this program especially for journalism students at Pennsylvania colleges and universities who want to learn about reporting on state government. Six to ten students will be selected. Must be a junior or senior majoring in journalism or communications. During three intensive days in Harrisburg, students will get hands-on experience, working with and mentored by professional journalists to produce a final project. Participants will also meet with lobbyists, legislators and more. Virtual sessions were held from 2020 through 2022. Spring 2023 dates tbd.
